I have received the monthly report on refugee data. The information contained in the report is consistent with the information we have received from the voluntary resettlement agencies in the state. In the fiscal year, 84 refugees have been resettled in the state from 8 different countries. Of those 84 refugees, two are of Syrian national origin. Between February 1 through February 29, 2016, twenty-two refugees were resettled in South Carolina from two countries (Belarus and Burma).
