

T. M. Motley, 68, Hurt Seriously By Automobile

T. M. Motley, 68, of W-8 Gonzales Gardens, was critically injured at 7:30 last night while crossing Gervais street near the Seaboard station. He was struck by an automobile driven by N. G. Brown of 342 South Harden street, Traffic Lieut. W. T. Ivey and Traffic Sgt. C. B. Bundrick were informed.

Both of Mr. Motley's legs were broken and his back injured. He was taken to the Baptist hospital.

Mr. Brown, who operates a liquor store in the 800 block of Harden street, was driving east on Gervais and the pedestrian was crossing from the north to the south side of the street, police said.

Mr. Motley was employed at one of the rehabilitation camps near here.
