Acting Ambassador Kathleen Stephens assumed her duties as (interim) Charge'd'Affaires in New Delhi early June 2014. Stephens is also the 2013-2014 Koret Fellow at Stanford University. Stephens resides in western Montana.

Ambassador Stephens served in the U.S. Foreign Service 1978-2013, achieving the rank of Career Minister. She was Acting Under Secretary of State for Public Diplomacy and Public Affairs in 2012, and U.S. Ambassador to the Republic of Korea, 2008 to 2011.

Ambassador Stephens' 35+ years of diplomatic service has included numerous senior posts in Washington, Asia, and Europe.

Ambassador Stephens holds a Bachelor degree in East Asian studies from Prescott College and a Master's degree from Harvard University, and also studied at Oxford University. She speaks Korean and Serbo-Croatian, with limited competence in Cantonese and Mandarin.
