FULL TRANSCRIPT:

For most people, 'my way or the highway' is a figure of speech. For State Senator Lee Bright, it's a campaign slogan.

If you've survived the traffic on I-85, or driven the crumbling highways in South Carolina, you know there's nothing more important than fixing our roads. Everyone agrees on that - except Lying Lee Bright.

Lee Bright said he was ALL ABOUT fixing our roads. Then he voted AGAINST the bill to fix our roads without raising taxes – TWICE.

He stood in the way, while more than 900 people died on our roads last year. Apparently, he'd rather talk about who can use which bathroom.

In eight years, only one of the 116 bills he authored was signed into law. Bright's done nothing for Upstate families, nothing to bring more jobs, nothing to fix the roads.

A large majority voted against Bright in the Primary, but this election's not over. In the June 28th runoff, tell Lee Bright HIS way, is the wrong way. On June 28, tell Lee Bright South Carolina deserves better.
