Dear Mr. Keck:

As the South Carolina Medical Association Childhood Obesity Task Force, we are writing concerning funding for the prevention and treatment of childhood obesity in South Carolina's 2014 Medicaid budget. As you know, the immediate and long term burden of obesity related conditions is overwhelming to our individual patients as well as to our state. SC is currently the 8th obese state in the country but is expected to move "up" to 5th by 2030 by which time predictions are that most South Carolinians (63%) will be obese. Therefore it is imperative that we address the current trend of rising childhood obesity with effective interventions to stem this tide.

We encourage you to fully support enhancement of Medicaid services that treat and prevent childhood overweight and obesity such as promoting best clinical practices, meaningful use of body mass index, and rewards for effective practice. We also feel this should include community and school-based prevention programs that provide individual assessment and education/counseling as well as system change through policies and environments that support healthy nutrition and increased physical activity.

We truly appreciate your collaboration and active participation in our work to improve the health of the children and adolescents in South Carolina.


