Memorandum

TO: Members, Commission on Higher Education

FROM: James R. Michael *JRM*

As you know, the Commission on Higher Education is responsible for Title I (Community Service and Continuing Education), Higher Education Act of 1965 as amended. On June 10, 1976, you approved the Annual Amendment to the State Plan for this program, setting forth guidelines and priorities for proposals to be submitted for funding during Fiscal Year 1977.

Last Fall, institutions submitted 32 preliminary proposals in accordance with the State Plan. The Advisory Council for Title I-A, HEA '65 (list of members attached), reviewed the preliminary proposals and selected 15 for development as formal proposals. On February 18, 1977, the Advisory Council met in Columbia to consider these 15 proposals and recommend those to be funded with the available \$148,148. Institutional representatives were invited to appear before the Council and make such oral presentations as deemed appropriate and to answer questions from members of the Council.

The Advisory Council recommends the following projects be approved and funded in the amounts shown:
