For instance, I hid a few more columns, narrowed columns A-C a bit, etc. Didn't mess with formulas or links, though.

More importantly...check out the cleverly named tab that appears next to it. It hides LOTS of columns, but gets all the key stuff in one place for NRH. Check out the formulas in AK and AL...I'm not sure if I'm hitting the right reference points in your flat file tabs...I wanted to get formulas in as placeholders, so feel free to change, if necessary. Also, check out the Division of Aeronautics in those columns. Looks like there's a busted formula maybe in the flat file...I don't wanna go messing with your stuff, though. The values in rows 116 are also just placeholders.

Anyway, depending on what you think, maybe we convert to using the "Awesome" tab version of reporting with her, starting next week... I think it might be the simplest we could get a master cheat sheet. Thanks.
