Subject: Capitol Complex Security System Reminder

Don't forget to bring your newly issued ID card and vehicle placard on Monday, July 1, when the new Capitol Complex security system will go into effect.

It is important to keep the following points in mind:

1. You will need either your parking placard or newly issued Proxy ID card each day to enter the garage.
2. It is essential you maintain a speed of **10 mph or less** when approaching the garage.
3. Your placard should be hung from the rearview mirror with the State Seal facing outward.
4. If the automated reader does not detect your placard, scan your Proxy ID card at the entrance gate.
5. You will need your Proxy ID card to access the garage from buildings located on the Capitol Complex.
6. Speed humps are being installed at the entrances to the garage to help ensure that the 10 mph or less speed is maintained.
