The South Carolina Black Pride Board of Directors invites you to exhibit at our 11th Annual Community Expo; our theme this year is **"LIVE OUT PROUD"**. This event will be held on Saturday, August 20th, at **MEADOWLAKE PARK**. The Expo will take place from 11:00 am until 4:00 pm. Last year we had an attendance of 600-750 people. The Expo will feature live entertainment and family fun. We welcome you to come and share the information about your organization or to market your goods and services.

Vendors should be mindful that children may be present at this Expo. If your booth will contain items that are of an adult-nature, these items must be displayed so that they are out of the reach of children. We will also have giveaways and other contests throughout the day, so feel free to donate an item or two for our raffles.

The cost is **\$185 (For food truck vendors) \$110 (For Profit Groups & food vendors – selling items) and \$90.00 (Non-Profit/Governmental Agencies)**. Vendor spaces are available from 11:00 am to 4:00pm. All vendors are responsible for clean-up, and must have displays completely broken down by 5:00pm.

South Carolina Black Pride strongly recommends bringing your own table and chairs however, if there is a need, SC Black Pride can rent 6 ft tables and 2 chairs for **\$20**.

I declare by signing this form that all of the information that I have provided is accurate and true. I also understand that South Carolina Black Pride reserves the right to eliminate my booth and keep my payment if:

- (1) The information I have given is not accurate;
- (2) I do not treat SC Black Pride leaders or guests at the event with dignity and respect.

Terms and Conditions:

1. The acceptance of all applications is based on when they are received by the SC Black Pride, a confirmation email will be sent upon receipt of application and payment.
2. The Expo is a community event. Diversity of vendor items/information is encouraged.
3. All vendors are required to set-up between 9:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m., to be open by 11 am, to remain open until 4:00 p.m., tear down starting at 4:15 p.m. and vacate the premises no later than 5 p.m.
4. Noise, smoke, visual displays shall not interfere with neighboring vendors or with the enjoyment of the public at the Expo and must comply with all park rules, municipal ordinances, and fire laws.
5. All business or other activity for which the vendor has rented space must be conducted in your designated area only. No distribution or solicitation of any kind may be done by strolling through the Expo, without prior written permission.
6. Vendors must be mindful that children will be present at this Expo and it is a family-oriented event. If your booth contains items that are of an adult-nature, these items must be displayed so that they are out of the reach and plain sight of children.
7. **FOOD TRUCK VENDORS:** EXPO VENUE does permit the sale of food. All food vendors MUST have a SC DHEC permit, a SC business license and a Richland County business license. Please submit proof of both with your application.
8. Vendors are responsible for any damages caused to other vendors, the EXPO VENUE property or to the event.
9. Applicants understand that S.C. Black Pride has no control over the weather, acts of God, acts of terrorism, governmental intervention, or any other cause that may prevent and/or interrupt the celebration; as such, all participants shall hold S.C. Black Pride harmless of any losses that could arise because of such events.
10. The applicant agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless, S.C. Black Pride, the EXPO VENUE, or any other corporation or entity should the event location change, from any claim, demand, suit, loss, cost of expense, or any damage which may be asserted, claimed, or recovered against or from the said parties by reason of any damages to property, personal injury, or bodily injury, including death, sustained by any person whomsoever and which damage, injury or death arises out of or is incident to or in any way connected with the expo, and regardless of which claim, demand, loss, cost or expense in whole or in part by the negligence of the Richland County Recreation Commission's staff or by third parties or by agents, servants, employees or factors of any of them.
