

Dear Ms. Kirk:

This is a follow-up to our April 20, 2011, May 6, 2011, and May 13, 2011 responses to your FOIA request of March 30, 2011. I again apologize for the delay in getting this information to you. The CD entitled "FOIA Docs for Appeal" includes items 4-6 or your original (first) request. I believe that this information completes our initial response to the original, March 30, 2011, request. As to item #10, Ms. Carrington has no memory or record of such a presentation. It is possible that someone else made the presentation. We would be happy to look further if you have any more specific information.

With respect to your follow-up (second request) of May 17, 2011:

- Item #1: enclosed are the unredacted copies of the documents.
- Items #2 and #3: we believe these were properly redacted of PHL.
- Item #4 through Item #11: copies of the documents responsive are enclosed.
- Item #12: we are researching this request, and may need to supplement.
- Item #13: is on the CD so designated.
- Item #14: the writer of this document does not remember that there was a follow-up.
- Item #15 and #16: are enclosed.
- Item #17: we are looking for documents that may have been overlooked.
- Item #18: there are none.
- Item #19: documents are enclosed, but may be duplicative of documents previously submitted.
- Item #20: we are looking for documents that may have been overlooked.
- Items #21 through #24: are enclosed, and some may be duplicative of documents previously submitted.
- Items # 25 and #26: are enclosed.
- Item # 27: there are none.
- Item # 28: the speaker was referring to the absence of system edits for automatically stopping payment of "unbundled" services had not yet been activated.
- Item #29: there are none.
- Item # 30: is enclosed, with the exception of bates #s 0474, 0475, 0782, 2383, and 2557, all of which reveal the identity of complainants about specific providers.

There are no documents responsive to your latest (third) FOIA request on documents related to the referenced disallowance.


