Open Sesqui Trails:

0.5 mile Jackson Creek Nature Trail

2.0 mile Sandhills Hiking Trail

6.0 mile Bike/Hike Trail

Partially Closed Trails:

3.5 mile Loop Road

There is an impassable section of the Loop Road Trail closest to the Day-Use area & park office. This section was washed away in the October 2015 floods. Loop Road does connect to other trails and those sections are open, so you can work around & bypass the washout in a round-a-bout way.
