On Greenville where we live traffic goes such a problem that in the two years we live on my street there have been at least 5 auto accidents that are "very preventable". The problem is on East North St. between Belhans Rd. and Hargraves there is only one stop light that trips when side vehicles trip the signal at Beaufort St. (see map).

Problem number 2 is can we turn the red light so much that can have been hit even though they had the green light. For all the accidents were due to speeding beyond the 40 mph limit. The stretch of traffic from Belhans to Hargraves is like a freeway to avoid extra lights on adjacent street. This is a minor problem for you, but if you can provide the Dept. + Transportation to look at this problem, maybe it can change the "accidentality" driver to stop speeding.

Our suggestion are those: install cameras, make the stop light at Beaufort St. turn red when entering can turn side street and driveway, put in side lane or install large mirror to see oncoming traffic near the curve going east. We don't want to see deaths due to speeders before action is taken. Thank you. I emailed Amy Burns of the Greenville news some time ago to bring this issue to light but no response yet.
