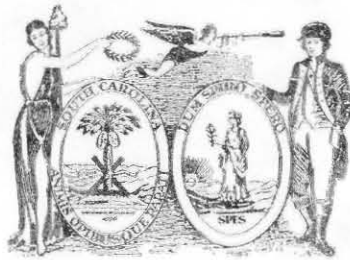

**WHEREAS**, a vacancy exists in the office of Aiken County Coroner as a result of the death of Sue Townsend; and




