Wardens:

Based on the projected strength uncertain movement and potential impact of Hurricane Matthew all institutions are to go into total lockdown status effective at 2100hours / 9:00pm tonight October 4, 2016. Institutions are to remain locked down after completion of your 9pm Rollcall Count tonight. This precautionary measure is necessary to ensure the safety and security of our institutions employees and inmates. The institutions will remained on lockdown status until directed to return to normal operations by Mr. McCall.

All programs and inmate visitation is cancelled until further notice. DO NOT PUBLICIZE THE VISITATION CANCELLATION TO ANYONE. We do not want to inform the inmate population at this point in time.

Institutions will be authorized to utilize only the number of inmates necessary to prepare meals. The inmate cafeteria workers must be escorted to and from the cafeteria. During this inclement weather lockdown period inmates will be fed in their housing units.

Wardens are reminded to ensure that all vehicles are fully fueled prior to the arrival of the inclement weather. Experience tells us there is a high potential for electrical power outages effecting the operation of fuel pumps.

Wardens should ensure that all items i.e., pallets barrels trash cans building materials etc., are secured to avoid becoming projectiles during high wind occurrences. This is extremely important to avoid personal injury as well as to prevent damage to the fence lines, building windows, vehicles and other agency property.

All locations should ensure that their emergency generator is operational and that emergency generator fuel tanks have an adequate fuel supply.

The Central Bus Terminal will not be operational Wednesday or Thursday of this week. All unnecessary transportation should be cancelled beginning Wednesday morning until further notice. Our priorities are safety and security. REMEMBER THERE ARE NO SHORTCUTS TO GOOD SECURITY.

The Wardens of Institutions equipped with the 800 base radio should conduct a radio check with EAC tomorrow (Wednesday) morning. In the event utilities/phone services are interrupted the 800 radio will provide communication ability. When conducting your 800 radio check you should be on the SCDOC channel. Please conduct this radio check between 9 and 10 am Wednesday morning.
