## Yesterday's Floor Action

**Senate** – Senator Massey proposed an amendment to S.1163 which would allow DSS to discuss non-public unfounded cases in front of the General Assembly and its committees as long as such testimony is given in front of a closed session. The amendment passed. The bill was carried over.

In addition, the Senate spent considerable time debating Senator Martin's election bill (S.866). They substituted S.866's language with H.3198 – the House's version of the same bill. The Senate will take up the bill again tomorrow.

## Committee Action

Senate Finance continued working on the budget last night after a lengthy delay in getting started.
