R.E.: Legal Aid/ Help needed

Dear Respectable Party,

I'm writing in regards to three very important, urgent legal matters that needs to be addressed. I have sought relief in every possible way that I can think of to No Avail. I have addressed my concerns to the States where the legal concerns are located and my letters, and efforts go ignored. I am from South Carolina, so now I will exert my effort here.

I am tentatively scheduled for release from federal Prison on April 26th 2016. However, I have two (2) Detainers that could potentially keep me incarcerated longer due to extradition to the states, counties that have lodged the Detainer(s) against me. I have wrote the 911 telecommunicators that have lodged the Detainers as well as wrote the prosecutors and have had the Correctional systems officer here file an IAD to both

prosecuting offices.

Most importantly, Shenandoah County Virginia has falsely charged me with two counts of Grand Larceny. Warrant # 2015-000493-94. MR. Disp C. Ellerd, Shenandoah County Department of Emergency Communications faxed a warrant to this prison asking for a Detainer to be lodged Against Me. So, Mrs. Kim Ferreza here at the prison filed an IAD to the Commonwealth's Attorney's Office via U.S.P.S. Certified Mail, Return Receipt requested Tracking # 7015-0640-0006-8072-7009.

Furthermore, Alamance County N.C., specifically, Stephanie Chatron, Telecommunicator II for the Burlington, N.C. Police Dept. Also faxed a warrant of "obtaining Property By False Pretense" to this prison asking for a Detainer to be lodged Against Me. I have exhausted every possible Remedy in this Jurisdiction as well. U.S.P.S. Tracking # 7015-0640-0006-8072-6996, Mr. Pat Nadolski, District Attorney 212 W. Elm St. Graham, N.C. 27253.

These Detainers are affecting me to adequately participate in the Federal Bureau of Prisons Residential Re-entry program that will assist me with finding Housing and employment. I will be Released to Florence, S.C. under Jurisdiction of the United States Probation Office. The contact there is Mr. Maurcen Kinney 401 W. Evar St, Florence, S.C. 29501

My third legal issue is a Family issue. There is presently a petition Filed in Winchester, V.A. at the Juvenile and Domestic Relations Court concerning Custody of my son Dakota Marcus Davis. D.O.B: 10/07/2014. The petition was filed by my Wife's Mother, Leslie Carter Lathan. However, my wife recently was Released on Bond under Jurisdiction of the United States Probation Office in Harrisonburg, VA. Her name is Katie Carter Happel. She is Awaiting sentencing



for a Supervised Release Violation. Her violation consist of being Arrested for Attempting to purchase Heroin in Winchester, V.A. while on Federal Probation for a large Cocaine conspiracy. Katie Happel suffers from several Mental illnesses as well as Drug dependency issues and is Not Receiving any treatment but is Allowed to Reside at the same home as my son and her Mom, Leslie Lathan. Mrs. Lathan Permits her daughter Katie to care for my son alone, without supervision and without Receiving treatment.

I have Notified the Social Service office in Winchester, VA but my complaints are ignored because Mrs. Leslie Lathan is a Repeated member of that community. Due to the chaos and Katie's Refusal to Receive treatment, I filed for Divorce in the County of Granville, N.C. Katie was served with a copy via U.S.P.S. certified mail, Return Receipt Requested. Tracking # 7015-0640-0006-8071-6034

My father, Mr Joel Marcus Davis can retain custody of my son if permitted to do so. It's a better environment and without the constant presence of me or Katie. Katie as well as myself, need a little bit to get our lives together before being thrown directly back to our son without having adequate Drug Abuse treatment or employment.

Please Do what you can to address these issues I greatly Appreciate it and Am willing to do whatever Necessary to Straighten this Mess out
