Attached are the plans for your expansion space. We are in the process of getting these printed and submitted to the City for permitting. I will note that the plans examiner for the City is out all of next week, so we will be at the mercy of their schedule to get the permit to start the work. Usual permitting takes about 3 weeks, 2 weeks at best. Add a holiday in the mix and it could take a bit longer. I'll keep you posted. Let me know if you have any questions regarding the plans.

1. All the existing lights are controlled from the adjacent suite. So you are doing all new switching for this

space.

2. We know there is a VAV above the suite. So we need to relocate the thermostat and make sure this thermostat is controlling only the diffusers associated with our space.

- Show doorway from USC space into the hallway to the corner office.
- Lt. Gov. office doors and suite doors to have glass kits.
- No accent walls needed
- Finishes in the expanded USC space to match existing finishes in USC Suite 300.
- Finishes in the new Lt. Gov. space to match existing finishes in USC Suite 300.
- Existing VCT can remain and carpet can go over it. The floor can be feathered at edge of VCT for smooth transition.
