I'm sure you'll be happy when all the boxes are unpacked and you're settled in.

I'd like to request a brief meeting with Lt. Gov. Bryant when Leadership South Carolina holds our Legislative Day in March.

On Thursday, March 9<sup>th</sup>, Leadership South Carolina will be coming to the State House for our Legislative Day starting with a breakfast for state legislators and their staff at 8 am in the Blatt 112.

Many in Leadership SC's current Class of 2018 will be visiting the State House for the first time and I would like to request a meeting with Lt. Gov. Bryant that suits his schedule.

In terms of background, Leadership South Carolina is the state's oldest continuous leadership development programs and has more than 1700 graduates.

We prepare motivated South Carolinians for statewide public service for the benefit of SC's under-served communities. (I've attached a class directory.)

Our alumni can be found all over the state in board rooms, class rooms, schools, municipalities and elected offices. More than 80% of our graduates serve on at least one board or commission.

Each year 50 people are selected to participate in Leadership SC's 120+ hours of programming to learn about the challenges facing our state and opportunities to become change agents.

Since 2004, every class has been asked to complete a class project, resulting in more than \$450,000 raised for the benefit of our state. Projects ranged from adopting SC Priority Schools, to assisting the SC School for the Deaf and the Blind, helping with SC Special Olympics, awareness for senior care issues, creating a SC Day of Service and raising funds for SC Food Banks.

Please let me know if Lt. Gov. Bryant will be able to see us on March 9<sup>th</sup>, and if you have any questions. I'll be happy to stop by your office and talk to you.
