Witch-hazel, a shrub or small tree, blooms in late fall into winter. The flowers have four yellow petals looking like tiny, crinkled ribbons. It is one of the rare trees that have flowers and fruit at the same time. Seeds are mature when new flowers appear the following fall and the seed capsules pop open to propel two glossy seeds up to 30 feet away. Have you seen these blossoms? Now you know!
