Today is wed and the inmates in the Monticello dorm have not had showers since Sunday, they hace also went for a week at a time no showers, they didnt get lunch til two pm. Alot of times they do not get food at times other dorms do. For example one day they didnt feed then til nine pm and that was the breakfast from that morning where it had been sitting out on the rock since seven am. Would you please investigate that prison. Even tho those people made mistakes to out there they does not mean they are any less of a human being or they dont deserve to be treated like humans then the ones working there. They keep them on lock down supposedly because of short staff. So i feel that broad river needs to be looked into to find out why they are so short staffed. What is the problem.
