Dear Administrator:

As you may have read in Neil Schuster's January Board Decisions correspondence, AAMVA's Fraudulent Document Recognition training has undergone a number of changes. Recent decisions made by the AAMVA Board of Directors have been executed by AAMVA staff, finally making this valuable training readily available, and truly, at no cost to our jurisdiction members.

Specifically, those decisions were to:

- * Break the existing FDR course into logical modules
- * Make the course available in multiple formats
- * Discontinue costly support of an AAMVA-hosted Learning Management System (LMS)
- * Dissolve AAMVA University and the Education & Training Division
- * Reduce staff
- * Lift course delivery restrictions
- * Sunset AAMVA trainer and chief trainer certification
- * Deliver and update FDR to member jurisdictions free of charge

The FDR Level 1 e-Learning course will be available for download from the jurisdiction member's only section of the AAMVA website beginning March 1, 2009. An information package will be sent to jurisdictional training contacts. The package outlines the process for retrieving the course, delivery options and available resources. A copy is attached for your convenience.
