REGULAR MEETING - OCTOBER 18, 1983 - 7:00 p.m.

Mr. Gilreath called the meeting to order and Mr. Wiles gave the invocation.
Everyone stood and Pledged Allegiance to the flag.

On the motion of Mr. Wiles, seconded by Mr. Lynch, Council voted unanimously to approve the minutes from the October 4, 1983 meeting as mailed.

On the motion of Mr. Wiles, seconded by Mr. Alexander, Council voted unanimously to approve the second reading of Ordinance #43. (Emergency Preparedness)

Mr. Watson discussed bids that were sent out in September 1983, for ambulances for the County EMS Squad. Mr. Watson recommended that Council accepts the low bid from Counts Rescue Equipment Company in the amount of \$79,290.00. On the motion of Mr. Alexander seconded by Mr. Wiles, Council voted unanimously to accept the low bid as recommended.

Mr. O'Neal recommended that the request from the Solicitor's office to transfer \$1,000 from the Direct Assistance account #123.79 to the automotive repair account #123.28. be approved by Council. On the motion of Mr. Wiles seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to approve the recommended budget transfer.

Mr. O'Neal explained the reason for the budget amendment to ordinance #112, he also asked for Council's approval for the second reading to the amended ordinance. On the motion of Mr. Lynch, seconded by Mr. Wiles council voted unanimously to approve the second reading of the amended ordinance #118. (Amendment to Ordinance #112)

Mr. O'Neal added an additional ammendment to the budget transfer, to add \$1,000 to the Election Commission account #141.15, also add \$1,500 to the Registration Board account #160.01, for salary and wages. On the motion of Mr. Wiles seconded by Mr. Alexander, Council voted unanimously to also approve this on the second reading. (the addition to account #141.15 is for travel and subsistence) This \$2,500 came from the State.

On the motion of Mr. Wiles seconded by Mr. Lynch, Council voted unanimously to allow the County Administrator, Mr. Billy O'Neal to futher study Resolution #194 (Policies and Procedures manuel) before recommending changes. On the recommendation of Mr. O'Neal, Council voted unanimous to delete policy #G-100 until futher notice.

Mr. O'Neal presented to Council the need to transfer \$68.73 to comply with Mr. Wilton Mackey's (coronor) request for a new vehicle. The total cost of the new vehicle amounted to \$9,068.73. No action needed to be taken.

At this time Mr. O'Neal conducted a Public Hearing for any concerned citizen to speak for or against the Annexation of several lots into the Homeland Park Water District. No on wished to make any comments.

At this time residents of the lakeview subdivision presented to Council a petition with over 100% of residential signatures, to request that council consider the repaving of the three roads that comprise the area known as the Lakeview subdivision. Mr Lynch addressed the residents, and made it clear that the roads in question have been inspected, and would be paved very soon. (Before November)

On the motion of Mr. Lynch seconded by Mr. Wiles council voted unanimously to adopt the third and final reading of Ordinance #115. (Microsurgery Center) Mr. Lynch also added, he would like a financial breakdown of all building equipment etc., used in the process, not only in this matter, but on all bond issues approved by Council.

ON the motion of Mr. Rhodes seconded by Mr. Lynch, Council voted unanimously to the request of Mr. Morris Winn to delete section #5 of Ordinance # 70 on the first reading. Mr. Winn futher duscussed the need for Council approval to reappoint Mr. Wayne Yarbrough of District # and Ms. Nancy Hellams of District #2 for another term. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Alexnader, Council voted unanimously to approve.

Mrs. Mary Ann Dobbins asked to be deleted from the agenda.

Mr. Reid Garrison spoke to council concerning problems with hangars and with the Airport commission bringing lawsuits upon him. Mr. Wiles made a motion to have the Councnty Attorney and County Administrator look into problems concerning the County Airport and report back to Council. The motion was seconded by Mr, Rhodes and adopted uananimously by Council.

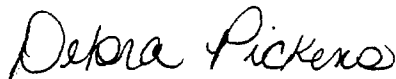
on the motion of Mr. Rhodes the County Attorney was directed to prepare an ordinance requiring prior approval by County Council before any County building is altered, repaired, built, removed, modified, demolished, condemned, rehabilitated, or improved. The motion was seconded by Mr. Lynch and unanimously adopted by Council.

on the motion of Mr. Rhodes the County Attorney was directed to prepare an ordinance requiring the County attorney to represent all Anderson County agencies, departments, boards, and commissions and for the Administrator or county Council to give prior approval before any agency, department, board or commission may file a complaint in State or Federal court. The motion was seconded by Mr. Lynch and unanimously adopted by Council.

At this time Council heard from concerned citizens.

Council adjourned at approximately 8:51 p.m.
