Thank you for forwarding me the information concerning your daughter, Rebecca. I can only imagine the stress and strain that her deteriorating health is causing your family. My thoughts and prayers are with her as she struggles through this difficult time. We have forwarded her information to Senator Lindsey Grahams' office for their assistance. We have also checked with Disability Determination Services in Columbia, they did advise us to recommend she obtain an attorney to assist with her claim, as an attorney is often very skillful in petitioning the Administrative Law Judge to move her case up. Unfortunately, they did confirm that the courts are very backed up and it may be 18 months or longer before her case could be heard.

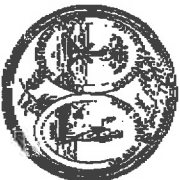



In Re: Social Security Disability


I applied for Social Security Disability in January of 2006. I was denied and filed an appeal. My case now is in the Office of Disability Adjudication and Review, Suite 200, 1927 Thurmond Mall Blvd, Columbia, South Carolina 29201. The telephone number is (803) 799-7771. The letter that I received from that office in March of 2007 was from Albert A. Reed, Hearing Office Chief Administrative Law Judge. I was told that the courts are very backed up and that it may be 18 months or longer before my case was heard.

I have been unable to work since May 2004 when I had six surgeries within 2 months. I have diabetes, multiple sclerosis, fibromyalgia rheumatice, interstitial cystitis, anemia, chemical imbalance, nephritis, migraines, hypertension, hyperthyroidism, bronchial asthma, costochondritis, and chronic sinusitis. My condition is getting so much worse since I have no insurance and cannot afford to see the specialists that I need to see. I cannot have the necessary tests run and obtain the medicine that I need to get better. I have been in the bed in excruciating pain for the last three weeks unable to walk very well or take care of myself. Each week I get weaker and weaker. I need help as soon as possible to alleviate this situation so that I get the medical help that I need.

I am asking for your immediate help regarding my case. If there is anything that you can do to help expediate my claim, would you please contact the proper authorities?
