Just below the surface of Colonial Dorchester are the archaeological remains of a town, a virtual time capsule of colonial history. Archaeologists and historians work together to uncover the past. Lot 52, on the corner of High Street and the Market Place, has been a focus for several years. Historic records suggest Joseph Blake owned the lot in 1742. Artifacts recovered include bricks, ceramics, nails, glass, butchered animal bones, furniture hardware, shutter hinges and barrel bands. Based on the features and artifacts uncovered, perhaps the structure was a kitchen/residence.
