Governor's Proclamation

WHEREAS, founded in 1912 by community volunteers, the Greenville Hospital System University Medical Center (GHS) has grown to become one of South Carolina's most comprehensive not-for-profit healthcare networks; and

WHEREAS, throughout its five campuses and multiple primary and specialty practices, the GHS team, including approximately 1,200 physicians and medical staff, 2,800 registered nurses, 10,000 employees, and over 1,200 volunteers, is dedicated to offering patients care that is both advanced and accessible; and

WHEREAS, GHS is the only university medical center in the Upstate and is engaged in the development of an academic health system focused on improving healthcare delivery through education, research, and clinical services; and

WHEREAS, for the past 100 years, GHS has evolved to meet the needs of the expanding Upstate community while upholding its commitment to providing both compassionate, personal care and the most innovative medical treatments available in order to ensure optimum patient outcomes.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim January 10, 2012, as
