NARRATIVE

-Septima Clark Academy- On todays date Dr. HaLevi addressed juvenile student, [REDACTED], regarding her dress which he believed to be an inappropriate length. After several interactions between Dr. HaLevi and the student she agreed to wear the sweatpants. As school was being let out Dr. HaLevi, via the school radio, requested the Student Concern Specialist, Dion Davis, ensure he retrieved the school issued sweat pants from the student. Mr Davis advised he believed the student was in the bathroom at that time. Mrs. Smith from Guidance checked the bathroom and did not locate her. At that time Dr. HaLevi told Mr. Davis to stop all buses from leaving to find [REDACTED] After the buses sat for several minutes I became concerned and drove over to the bus loop. As I exited my vehicle I saw Dr. HaLevi on the bus walking from the rear of the bus to the front with the sweat pants in his hands. As I walked over Dr. HaLevi advised the bus could now leave and the driver started the bus. When I came around to the passenger side I saw Ms. Smith and went to speak with her and Dr. HaLevi who had exited the bus and walked over to us with the sweat pants. At that time [REDACTED] stuck her head out of the window crying and began screaming that he was making her ride the bus without any pants on that she was in her underwear. Ms. Smith and I looked at Dr. HaLevi and he said "What!" and Ms. Smith repeated what we heard then Dr. HaLevi told Mr. Davis to stop the bus. Dr. HaLevi then boarded the bus and we could here students speaking to him but not what they were saying. He exited the bus minus the sweat pants and said they (the students) were saying she didn't have her dress on. He didn't understand what they were talking about and where her dress was and asked that I find out who had it. I entered the bus and found [REDACTED] in the last seat and asked where her dress was and if I needed to go into the school to get it for her. The students advised that another student had it that had left and that they told Dr. HaLevi she didn't have any clothes to put on. At that time I observed [REDACTED] wearing what appeared to be a t shirt, zip up sweat shirt, and panties. The sweat pants were next to her on the seat. I advised Dr. HaLevi that the dress was not on the bus and that her mother needed to be contacted and notified of this incident. He agreed and requested her number via the radio. He re-entered the bus to speak with the students and advise them he didn't know she wasn't wearing the dress. The bus driver who is from the same area and close with [REDACTED] spoke to her and [REDACTED] was also speaking to her mother, Linda Hamilton, on the phone. She then exited the bus per her mother's instructions and walked with Ms. Smith, still crying, to the Data Clerk's Office. Mrs. Heyward, teacher, arranged to meet [REDACTED]'s mother and left the school with [REDACTED] while still speaking to her mother. I called Durham Bus Services and left a voicemail for the supervisor of bus# 808 requesting a copy of the video. Mrs. Hayward returned a few minutes later and advised that Linda Hamilton was coming to the school. Dr. HaLevi asked that we continue to wait for her to arrive to have a meeting with her. Mrs. Hamilton arrived at the school but remained by her car. She was very upset and yelling. She stated she wasn't going to talk to anyone until Monday when she would return with her lawyer. I was unable to get a statement from [REDACTED] because she was so upset. I notified Sgt. Brinson of the incident. Sgt. Brinson notified Captain Tittle and Michael Reidenbach (Director of CCSD Security) Sgt. Brinson also contacted Mrs. Hamilton and arranged to meet with both her and [REDACTED] on Monday morning. The investigation is on going.
