The good news is that at this stage it is just an appeal from a summary court conviction, not a civil lawsuit, so no Answer needs to be filed. As with many pro se filings, the relief sought in the document we first received from Mr. Sarim was inartfully stated. We sent that document to the IRF to the extent that it arguably could be considered to seek damages under the Tort Claims Act.

The IRF is not involving itself in the matter for now. We will let you know if that changes.
