Here are some quick updates about the expanding world of VisionLink:

- 1) VisionLink was selected to support a multi-year project with [United Way World Wide](#) and the [Centers on Disease Control and Prevention](#) to provide the national public information surge capacity platform for national pandemics, in collaboration with 2-1-1s.
- 2) VisionLink is working with the [National Academy Foundation](#) to build better connections between young people and their careers for hundreds of academies across the country. National employer partners include: AT&T, Cisco, HP, Johnson & Johnson, JPMorgan Chase, Travelers, Xerox, and other leading employers.
- 3) VisionLink was asked by the [American Red Cross](#) to build the next generation of the [National Shelter System](#) on our new software platform.
- 4) We are excited to be working with [Asylee Women Enterprise \(AWE\)](#). Based in Baltimore, Maryland, Asylee Women Enterprise helps women seeking asylum to rebuild their lives and their spirits.
- 5) VisionLink now supports two integrated telephony solutions, [InContact](#) and [Connect First](#). [The United Way of Southern Kentucky](#) will be deploying a state-of-the-art integrated solution from VisionLink and Connect First.
- 6) VisionLink was recently awarded a contract with the [City of Houston](#) to improve whole community response and coordination after a disaster, by enhancing [Crisis Cleanup](#).
- 7) Sandboxes for our new software platform are being released to: [2-1-1 Pennsylvania](#), [United Way of Abilene](#), [United Way of Northern Nevada](#) and the [Sierra](#), [United Way of Escambia County](#), and [SC Access](#). This new platform redefines the paradigm of community information systems.
