#### Description/Significant Features:

A non-functioning lighthouse, ca. 1970, is situated adjacent to Tavern & Table's (Resource 08005) northeast corner. The octagonal, stucco-covered lighthouse is multiple stories tall and features a glassed-windowed, octagonal lantern room supported by the tower structure. The lantern room, at the top of a lighthouse, typically contains the lamp and lens. No lamp or lens is in this lighthouse. An octagonal watch room is below the lantern room. An octagonal galley or open platform is outside of the watch room. The exterior is painted black and white horizontal stripes.

100 Church Street, with its black-and-white lighthouse, once housed a seafood restaurant named The Trawler before becoming an event venue, Lighthouse on Shem Creek. Now the building houses Tavern & Table.
