SECTION 1: The Minutes for the meeting of September 20, 2001; copies of which had been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 2: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the sale of surplus right of way property, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 3: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting a report by the Department of contract modification #15-99, PIN #22338 & 26183, File #8.790 & #8.790.1, Project #BRT-BIU-IIBM(008), Berkeley County, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 4: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in removing roads from the State Highway Secondary System, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 5: The Commission unanimously passed a motion correction the description of sections of state highways previously added to the State Highway System as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 6: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the request of the Department to award highway construction contracts from the September 11, 2001 letting, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 7: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the request of the Department to remove a highway construction project in Kershaw County from the letting of September 11, 2001, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 8: On motion of Commissioner Mack, duly seconded, the Commission unanimously passed a motion approving a resolution naming the new Chesterfield County Construction office as the "Boyd M. Rogers Building". A copy of the resolution is shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 9: On motion of Commissioner Mack, duly seconded, the Commission unanimously passed a motion to approving a resolution naming the I-26/SC 34 Interchange in Newberry County as the "James A. Lander Interchange". A copy of the resolution is shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 10: On motion of Commissioner Atkins, seconded by Commissioner Mack, the Commission unanimously passed a motion adopting a resolution congratulating M. Lee Powell, II for receiving the Hartmann-Hirshman Award. A copy of the resolution is shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 11: On motion of Commissioner Harrell, seconded by Commissioner Stoddard, the Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to restrict to the right two lanes, where appropriate, truck traffic on interstate highways with three or more lanes in each direction.



SECTION 12: On motion of Commissioner Mack, seconded by Commissioner Hardee, the Commission unanimously passed a motion supporting the designation of a future high speed rail stop in the Town of Cheraw. A letter, for Commissioner Mack's signature, will be prepared to the Mayor of the Town of Cheraw indicating the Commission's support for this future stop on the high speed rail line.

## **Appendix**

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1. **File 23.299A / Interstate I-185 (Southern Connector) / Greenville County**

During construction of improvements on Interstate I-185 (Southern Connector), under File 23.299A in Greenville County, near the City of Greenville, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 20 and Old Pelzer Road, by Dedication under The Beltline Act dated May 1, 1937.

While negotiating for new right of way on Interstate I-185 (Southern Connector) by the consultant (PAN Inc.) it was agreed that the Department should convey the subject surplus parcel to the adjacent owner as credit towards new right of way needed on the project. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.2 of an acre of land to Piedmont Partners, A South Carolina General Partnership was executed on September 7, 2001.

2. **File 23.299A / Interstate I-185 (Southern Connector) / Greenville County**

During construction of improvements on Interstate I-185 (Southern Connector), under File 23.299A in Greenville County, near the City of Greenville, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 20 and Pelzer Road, by Dedication under The Beltline Act dated May 1, 1937.

While negotiating for new right of way on Interstate I-185 (Southern Connector) by the consultant (PAN Inc.) it was agreed that the Department should convey the subject surplus parcel to the adjacent owner for settlement of negotiations. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.19 of an acre of land to Margaret W. Simpson was executed on September 7, 2001.

3. **File 23.131A / Road S-85 (Easley Bridge Rd) / Greenville County**

During construction of improvements on Road S-85 (Easley Bridge Rd), under File 23.131A in Greenville County, near the City of Greenville, the Department acquired right of way for Road S-85 by Condemnation from Marshall D. Earle, et al dated April 17, 1990.

While acquiring for new right of way for the above project, the department agreed to convey a small piece of surplus property to the Grantees in exchange for new right of way of equal size that was needed for the project. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.126 of an acre of land to Lydia Martin Sawyer, Bell Mead Heckel and Bobby Jane Traylor was executed on September 7, 2001.

4. **File 46.891 / SC-Route 161 Extension / York County**

During construction of improvements on SC Route 161 Extension, under File 46.891 in York County, near the City of Rock Hill, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 161 by Condemnation from J. B. Fisher dated November 21, 1995.

This is a request from the Legal Department and the City of Rock Hill for the department to execute a quitclaim deed to clear up a discrepancy in the title on a parcel of land owned by the city. The York County Records Office shows the department as joint owner by mistake. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.25 of an acre of land to The City of Rock Hill was executed on September 10, 2001.

5. **File 42.108B / SC Route 80 / Spartanburg County**

During construction of improvements on SC Route 29, under File 42.231 in Spartanburg County, near the Town of Greer, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 29 by Deed to Real Estate from Mr. & Mrs. W. R. Bailey dated September 27, 1940.

After acquiring new right of way for the above project, the plans were revised and less right of way was needed. The department agreed to convey back to the Grantee a small parcel of surplus right of way for credit towards to the original right of way acquisition and to avoid paying damages to this owner. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.07 of an acre of land to Roy L. Patch was executed on October 4, 2001.

6. **File 19.441 / Road S-400 / Edgefield County**

During construction of improvements on Road S-400, under File 19.441 in Edgefield County, near the City of Augusta, the Department acquired right of way for Road S-400, by Right of Way Easement from W. H. Presley dated September 22, 1975; from Peter G. Horne, Estate by Right of Way Easement dated September 25, 1975.

A request was made from the adjacent owner and District 2 (DEA Brooks) for the department to convey a portion of Road S-400 back to the requestor and original owner of the roadbed. The requestor and original owner gave the easement interest of the roadbed to the Department gratis in 1975. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 1.6 acres of land to W. H. Presley was executed on October 4, 2001.

September 28, 2001

The Department requests Commission approval to perform a Contract Modification to the Basic Agreement for On Call Structure Foundation Testing Services. This Contract Modification (No. 15-99) was made and entered into on September 28, 2001 by and between the SCDOT and SM&E for \$21,506.00. The funding will come from the engineering inspection allotment set up for this project. The Basic Agreement was entered into on September 1, 1999.
