### **Unholy Political Alliance**

As for his appearance before the Joint Session of Congress, arranged, ironically, by **Speaker John Boehner**, Pope Francis did not disappoint. As predicted, the Pope aligned himself with **President Obama** and, by extension, the **United Nations** on global warming, and hinted at global redistribution of wealth.

The Pope seemed unafraid to bash the **Republican views of his host**, Speaker

Boehner, while,

at the same time, appearing **loathe to criticize the Democrat left** -- many of whom are **pro-abortion catholic politicians** such as **Congresswoman Nancy Pelosi, Secretary of State John Kerry, and Vice President Joe Biden.** (More on this later.)

**Please note:** While we are criticizing the Pope for the unnecessary politicization of economic and scientific issues on this trip, we praise him for his spiritual compassion -- especially evidenced by his visitations with the Little Sisters of the Poor, the imprisoned in Northeast Philadelphia, and victims of the church's child abuse sex scandal.

**Group Condemns Pope's Unholy Political Alliance with President on Global Warming;  
Suggests Pontiff Weigh Both Sides in Dispute; Calls on Pope to Address American Spiritual Crisis**

Philadelphia (September 23, 2015) -- The Independence Hall Foundation, an organization with several thousand Catholic adherents, is condemning the "unholy political alliance" between Pope Francis and President Barack Obama regarding the issue of climate change as evidenced, earlier today, by the Pope's comments during a joint public appearance with the President on the White House lawn.

Fox news quoted Pope Francis as saying:

"Mr. President, I am finding it encouraging that you are proposing an initiative for reducing air pollution, accepting the urgency. It seems clear to me also that

climate change is a problem which can no longer be left to future generations. When it comes to the care of our common home we are living at a critical moment of history," Francis said to applause from the gathered crowd.

"We do, however, dispute the alarmism of most global warming activists, led by President Obama and Al Gore, who propose, as a solution, the carbon taxing of wealthier nations, such as the United States, and then the redistribution of those funds to poorer nations.

"The scheme would require the enforcement of a world body not unlike the United Nations. It would also cause enormous inflation, especially pertaining to energy costs, in the world's post-industrialized, industrialized, and developing nations.

"Our Foundation also disputes the notion that human activity is solely responsible for climate change," said Ms. Adams.

At a press conference, last Thursday, on Independence Mall, the Foundation was joined by experts from the Chicago-based think tank, The Heartland Institute, who opined that human activity is not causing a climate crisis.

The presser was held to debunk myths about the causes and consequences of global warming and to discuss erroneous Papal teachings on the climate and the nature of Capitalism, especially those espoused in the Pope's most recent encyclical, *Laudato Si'*.

"While we are not skeptical regarding the existence of climate change, we are skeptical of Pope Francis's political alignment with President Obama and United Nations officials whose alarmist positions on global warming are not settled science and whose remedies would bring about massive layers of government involvement -- including a new world governing authority," said Ms. Adams.

"There are two sides in this dispute. While a majority of scientists tend to agree
