Within the confines of the forest are a nursery, classroom, playground, filter, sanctuary, rest stop and neighborhood. A diversity of animals raise their young and live their entire lives in this small area. Birds take a pit stop during migration for food and protection. Plants provide oxygen, food, and filter pollutants. People camp, relax, and learn. Take a walk along the Sculptured Oak Nature Trail to explore this rare and unique habitat and help protect it for future generations!
