Myrtle Beach, Huntington Beach, Edisto Beach and Little Pee Dee state parks along with Charles Towne Landing, Hampton Plantation and Colonial Dorchester state historic sites are closed until further notice due to mandatory hurricane evacuation orders. All other parks are currently open for business.

If you have a reservation at any of the parks listed above during the evacuation period, these reservations days will be cancelled and you will be fully refunded.
