Mr. Poore called the meeting to order and Councilman Hooper gave the invocation.

On the motion of Mr. Wiles, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to approve the June 3, 1980 minutes as mailed.

Mr. Bill Thompson discussed renting the old Gene Anderson Building. He discussed three alternatives which were:

- (1) The County could lease the building as is for 5 years for \$1200.00 a month.
- (2) Mr. Thompson would remodel a certain portion - lease for 7 years for \$2,000.00 a month.
- (3) Sell for \$85,000.

Council received as information.

Mrs. Jean Taylor with PATH approached Council asking for the full amount of \$6,000 asked for in her budget request for 1980-81. Judge Dean reinforced what Mrs. Taylor had said.

Mr. Harry Thompson and Mr. G.G. Galloway approached Council for additional monies for the Recreation Commission's 1980-81 FY Budget. Mr. Galloway stated that the \$30,000 requested would not be enough.

Mr. Haynie presented Council with two petitions regarding Howard Burton road. One petition concerned the condition of the road and the other was renaming the road (Canfield Road) which was the original name. Mrs. Millie Burden spoke against changing the name. Council received as information.

Mr. Poore read his letter to the County Council and the public regarding his proposed 1980-81 FY budget. David Watson read first reading of Ordinance #56 - 1980-81 Fiscal Year Budget. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Wright, Council voted 4 in favor with Mr. Wiles abstaining to adopt on first reading Ordinance #56.

On the motion of Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to adjourn at 10:10 a.m.
