



MONDAY PRO-AM INFO

PARKING

Your Parking Hangtag will be issued to you at registration. This pass must be displayed at all times.

Pro-Am Contestants will park in Lot 15 at the intersection of Lighthouse Road and Lighthouse Lane **Monday** only. A golf cart shuttle will be provided to transport Contestants, bags and guest to the clubhouse.

All Pro-Am Contestants will park in Lot 10 just off the Fraser Circle on Lighthouse Road (next to the Fire Station) for the remainder of the week. Shuttle service is provided to the front of Harbour Town Golf Links Clubhouse.

AWARDS RECEPTION

Prizes will be awarded to the amateurs on 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place Net teams. Heavy hors d'oeuvres and cocktails will be provided in the Harbour Town Conference Center following Pro-Am play. You and your Pro-Am guest are invited to attend.

GENERAL PRO-AM INFO

ENTRY/HANDICAP FORMS

Handicaps will be verified beginning March 15th and used in the Pro-Am with no exceptions. We will not change your handicap after it has been verified.

CADDIES

Each player is required to walk and use a caddie. A caddie will be provided for you unless you indicated on your Pro-Am participation form that you would be bringing your own. For caddies provided by the tournament the fee is covered by the tournament. A gratuity is at the discretion of the player; however, a minimum of \$30 (cash only) is recommended.

If you are bringing your own caddie, a caddie credential will be given to you for your caddie. It is the Pro-Am contestant's responsibility for distributing the required credential to his/her caddies prior to the tournament. It is also recommended that he/she ride with you to Harbour Town Golf Links. If your caddie is driving separately, please be aware that amateur caddies will park in general parking. Shuttle service will be provided to and from the tournament.

CREDENTIALS

Your Pro-Am credential and guest credential will be issued to you at registration. Your credential should be worn at all times while on tournament grounds for identification as a pro-am contestant and access to restricted Pro-Am areas on Pro-Am day only. This credential will be valid for tournament entry the entire week including Clubhouse access.

GENERAL PRO-AM INFO

PRACTICE RANGE

The Practice Range and Putting Green will be open and available for practice prior to Pro-Am play **on Pro-Am day only**.

FORMAT

Only contestants, amateurs and caddies are allowed inside the ropes. This will be strictly enforced.

DRESS CODE

Collared golf shirts are required for both men and women Pro-Am contestants along with their caddies. Golf-length walking shorts are allowed during tournament play. The pairings party and awards reception are golf casual. Only soft spike golf shoes are permitted.

NOTICE FROM PGA TOUR

1. RANGEFINDERS ARE NOT PERMITTED DURING THE PRO-AM

2. MAXIMUM AMATEUR SCORE

Each team is requested to play at a reasonable pace, no slower than 15 minutes per hole, or four 1/2 hours for the round, and to keep up with the group in front of them. The amateur player with the lowest handicap is responsible for assisting the professional in monitoring the pace of play. Amateurs cannot score higher than a net par on any hole. Amateurs are required to pick up if out of the hole. There is no individual competition for amateurs.

3. SUSPENSION OF PLAY PROCEDURES

The condition of competition adopted specifically for dangerous weather suspension is as follows:

When play is suspended for dangerous weather (i.e., lightning, tornado, high wind, etc.), if the players in a group are between the play of two holes, they shall not resume play until the Committee has ordered a resumption of play. If they are in the process of playing a hole, they shall discontinue play immediately and shall not thereafter resume play until the Committee has ordered a resumption of play. A suspension for dangerous weather shall be signaled by one prolonged siren or horn note.

All other types of suspension for non-dangerous weather (i.e., darkness, casual water, fog, etc.) shall be signaled by several short intermittent siren or horn notes. If players are in the process of playing a hole, they may continue provided they do so without any delay. If they choose to continue, they shall discontinue either before or immediately after completing the hole.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF THIS CONDITION: DISQUALIFICATION

Note: All practice areas shall be closed during suspension for dangerous weather until the Committee has declared them open for use.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

The following items are prohibited at RBC Heritage and will be confiscated:

Camera or video cameras (Thursday - Sunday)

Radios, TVs, signs or banners

Beverages or coolers

Firearms or weapons of any nature

No bags larger than a small purse (6"x6"), INCLUDING:

- Camera carrying cases
- Chair carry bags
- Backpacks
- Packages and other carrying items

All items are subject to search. You will be asked to return all unauthorized items to your car before you are allowed to board shuttles.

RAIN DELAY POLICY

In the event of rain on Pro-Am day, please follow the rules listed below to help us maintain an organized environment during any delays that may occur:

DO NOT CALL THE CLUB OR TOURNAMENT OFFICE.

1. Arrive at the course one hour prior to your tee time prepared to play.
2. Play will begin at scheduled tee times unless lightning is in the area and a delay is announced.
3. Play in progress will proceed unless lightning is in the area (horn will sound to evacuate).
4. In the event of a delay, amateur contestants are required to wait in the Harbour Town Conference Center where all instructions/announcements regarding play will be made.
5. Beverages, snacks or meals will be available in the Harbour Town Conference Center based on the length of the delay.

Inclement Weather Policy For Spectators



Observe the leaderboards throughout the golf course for “weather warning” signs that will appear prior to inclement weather moving into the area. When this sign appears, spectators are advised to take precautions **PRIOR** to play being suspended. If the siren sounds, seek shelter immediately.

Avoid the Following:

- *Open areas*
- *Hilltops/high places*
- *Isolated trees*
- *Golf carts*
- *Wire fences*

DIRECTIONS

To the Plantation Club (registration):


From the Sea Pines Main Gate follow Greenwood Drive to Fraser Circle. Travel $\frac{3}{4}$ around the circle taking your third exit onto Lighthouse Road. Travel approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile; you will see the Plantation Club on your left. From the Sea Pines Ocean Gate travel approximately 1.5 miles; you will see Plantation Club on your right.

PRO-AM PARKING

You must have your Pro-Am Parking Hangtag displayed from your rearview mirror at all times.

Pro-Am Day: Lot # 15

From the Sea Pines Main Gate follow Greenwood Drive to Fraser Circle. Travel $\frac{1}{4}$ around the circle taking your first exit onto Lighthouse Road. Travel approximately 1 mile; you will be directed into Lot #15 by security.
