I hope this finds you well. By this email, let me introduce you to Christian Soura, who is south Carolina Governor Haley's Deputy Chief of Staff; he's an alum also of the Rendell administration in Pennsylvania. Governor Haley recently called Mayor Bloomberg with an idea around funding the development of a residential energy efficiency program in SC. Since we thus far haven't funded state-level work at Bloomberg Philanthropies (as you know, my boss really believes in municipal government!) I don't know whether there's an opportunity for us here, but I suggested to Christian that given the potentially big message around the bipartisan nature of energy efficiency that a move by Gov Haley would create, this might be an attractive opportunity for you.

I'm also going to connect him to Dan Esty in Connecticut in case there's an opportunity for CT and SC to collaborate.
