Description/Significant Features: Road 1306.03 is an unnamed road that extends 2.10 miles generally southwest through the southern portion of the project tract. Road 1306.03 begins at its intersection with Road 1306.7 in the north-central portion of the project tract, extends 0.78 mile south and turns southwest for another 1.32 miles to the southwest before ending at Road 1306.04. Road 1306.03 intersects one non-historic road (B). Road 1306.03 averages 20 ft wide and 20-37 ft amsl elevation and its surface is an aggregate of dirt and gravel. Most of the roadbed lies at ground level except where it crosses through wetlands, where it is raised three to five ft above ground surface.

Historical Information

Historical Information: In addition to Line Road (Road 1306), Roads 1306.01-1306.04 comprise the remainder of the five roads on the project tract attributed to the plantation era (ca. 1675-1865).

Historic aerials and quadrangles show Road 1306.03 (USGS 1920, 1944, 1957, 1959, 1961, 1973). During the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries, this road provided direct access for Wragg's Middle and Savannah Plantations from Ashley River Road. It is likely Road 1306.03 was incorporated into Gregg's phosphate mining infrastructure as either a road or tramline. By the late twentieth century, Road 1306.03 served as one of the primary logging roads at Watson Hill (USGS 1973).
