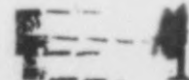
The meeting was held to give the Public Railway officials an opportunity to familiarize the Budget and Control Board with the current status of operations and plans for the future.

Mr. Betz and Mr. Morris made presentations and answered questions of Board members. They also indicated that they felt that, in the future, it may be desirable to construct and operate railroad facilities for new industries.

The Board accepted the data furnished as information but took no action during the current meeting.

After lunch, Governor West invited the Board members into the library and advised that he intended to address the General Assembly on the following day to recommend a second medical school and to announce that substantial funding would probably be made available through the Veterans Administration.
