For the 7th year in a row, volunteers came together, sponsored by DNR's South Carolina Oyster Restoration and Enhancement Program (SCORE) and the Friends of Hunting Island, to build oyster habitat at Russ Point Landing at Hunting Island State Park. Volunteers passed 675 20-lb. mesh bags of recycled oyster shell from trailers to water's edge. After 7 years, nearly 4,000 bags of shell have been placed at Russ Point, creating over 5,000 square feet of new habitat. These new oysters filter up to 31 million gallons of water every day—the equivalent of 470 Olympic-sized swimming pools, 365 days a year!
