Dear Grantees and Community Partners,

We would like to make you aware of a funding opportunity announcement through the Alzheimer's Disease Supportive Services Program.

There are two parts to the cooperative agreements available: Part A is a new three-year, forward funded grants to states that have not benefited from the program since 2011 and Part B is a program expansion opportunity through which existing grantees can apply to receive an 18 month expansion grant to build upon a successful component within the ACL ADSSP project they are presently implementing. Applicants eligible for the ADSSP program would be eligible for either Part A or Part B, there would be no applicant eligible to apply for both opportunities.
