Good morning Governor,

What fond memories there are of campaigning together with you, Nikki, in the Upstate. Thank you for your service. There is great respect in our hearts for your leadership and accomplishments in serving SC. It is disturbing, however, to learn that you are supporting a proposed refugee resettlement in Spartanburg. Sure Spartanburg County is the most international in SC, but is it wise to bring more now?

Dr. Jim Goodroe and I are dear friends, but we see immigration and refugee resettlement differently. Spiritually, I'm "all in" on the Great Commission of Jesus Christ to "GO" to all ethnic groups of the world with the Gospel. Jesus mission did not have a COME CLOSER resettlement strategy, and neither do I. There is no comfort in the UN vetting potential refugees to COME CLOSER. That entity is so seriously compromised that it's a threat to National Security.

I really appreciate Rep. Trey Gowdy's demand to delay plans to bring refugees here until a number of questions have been answered and citizens of Spartanburg County in particular have opportunity to ask questions and weigh the facts against the resettlement plan.
