#### Description/Significant Features:

Replacement synthetic siding throughout. Replacement wood frame 6/6 double-hung windows on main block with synthetic 6/6 windows on rear and additions. Corbel Chimney on south roof slope. Hip dormer windows on east and west elevation. West elevation dormer window (original) has 4 arched lights over 4 grid light windows. Porch includes replacement concrete floor and steps, original brick posts with battered supports. Front door a synthetic replacement. Side porch door appears original with large single light on top. Non historic rear additions.

Alterations (include date(s), if known):

Historic early to mid-century gable additions to south and south; west (rear) elevation has non-historic porch/sun room. Exterior chimney on west facade of west gable addition. Late twentieth-century addition to northwest corner. Replacement synthetic siding throughout. Enclosed shed roof porch on west elevation. Modern synthetic front door; facade windows 6/6 wood replacements.
