He has been served electronically and has acknowledged receipt of the Inspection Report (2/29). The report denotes a 30 day compliance timeline, however it is not unusual for us to work with property owners who are making progress and completion may be out of their control. At this point we have heard nothing other than the acknowledgement. The building has been posted by OSFM as "unsafe" and prohibiting occupancy.

The enforcement tool for OSFM is the ALC. Initially we may try to assist Camden in their efforts.
