SECTION 1: The Minutes of the meeting of June 21, 1990; copies of which have been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 2: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving purchase orders issued for amounts in excess of \$1,000.00 during the month of June, 1990, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 3: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in entering into supplemental agreement number 3 with Parsons Brinckerhoff Quade and Douglas extending the scope of services for site monitoring of weather for additional year in connection with the fog mitigation system for the I-526 Cooper River bridge project, at a cost not to exceed \$133,577.21, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 4: The Commission unanimously passed a motion changing the designation number for a supplemental agreement with Deleuw Cather & Co./LPA Group, Inc. Joint Venture to provide mapping of approximately 12.4 miles of U. S. Route 521 which was previously approved by the Commission from Supplemental Agreement Number 2 to Supplemental Agreement Number 1, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 5: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with Burton and Associates, Inc. for short range safety planning and technical assistance project not to exceed a contract maximum of \$21,428, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 6: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with Burton and Associates, Inc. to conduct a comprehensive public transportation capital inventory project for a contract maximum not to exceed \$49,836, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 7: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with Budget and Control Board's Human Resource Management Division to provide the Department's Public Transportation Division logistical assistance and be responsible for workshop facility arrangements, promotional material and distribution, preregistration and registration, lodging and meals for workshop participants, in the amount of \$49,344, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 8: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with the South Carolina Department of Parks, Recreation and Tourism to conduct a study and assessment of the needs and impact of public transportation on the State's tourism industry for a contract maximum not to exceed \$35,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 9: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting a report of the Department concerning the execution of a gratis quitclaim deed dated October 13, 1990 conveying 14,550 square feet of land on U. S. Route 378 B.P. & Road S-1034 in Sumter County to Myers-Park, Inc., as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 10: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting a report of the Department concerning the execution of a quitclaim deed dated April 17, 1990 conveying 1,300 square feet of land on Road S-1081 in Darlington County to William E. It is recommended that Supplemental Agreement No. 3 to the Consultant Agreement dated September 10, 1986 between the Department and Parsons Brinkerhoff Quade and Douglas be approved. The effect of this supplement is to extend the scope of services for site monitoring of weather for an additional year in connection with the fog mitigation system for the I-526 Cooper River bridge project and to acquire two additional fog monitors to be used as part of the mitigation system. The amount of the extension would not exceed \$133,577.21. The fog mitigation system on this structure and the monitoring program was required by federal court as a result of the litigation filed by Westvaco Corp., Charleston & Berkeley Counties.

AGREEMENT WITH BURTON AND ASSOCIATES

At the June 15, 1989, meeting of the Commission, the Department was given authorization in its public transportation program of projects to provide planning and technical assistance to the Department and transit providers in the areas of safety and risk management. The authorization allowed for the expenditure of State General Funds (\$19,100) and State Highway Funds (\$2,900) to be used for this purpose.

With this approval, a bid solicitation, review and selection process was conducted through the Department's Purchasing Division to secure consultant services for safety/risk management planning and technical assistance. The Purchasing Division has concluded that Burton and Associates, Inc., submitted the most responsive proposal.

It is recommended that the Commission authorize the Department to enter into an agreement with Burton and Associates, Inc., for short range safety planning and technical assistance project not to exceed a contract maximum of \$21,428.

AGREEMENT WITH BURTON AND ASSOCIATES

At the March 15, 1990, meeting of the Commission, the Department was given authorization in its State Strategic Highway Plan for Improving Mobility and Safety Construction Program (SHIMS) to procure consultant services to conduct a comprehensive public transportation capital inventory study (Item #: 100,288). The authorization allowed for the expenditure of \$49,993 in SHIMS funds to be used for this purpose.

With this approval, a bid solicitation, review and selection process was conducted through the Department's Purchasing Division to secure consultant services for the above project. The Purchasing Division has concluded that Burton and Associates, Inc., submitted the most responsive and responsible proposal.

It is recommended that the Commission authorize the Department to enter into an agreement with Burton and Associates, Inc., to conduct a comprehensive public transportation capital (equipment and real property) inventory project for a contract maximum not to exceed \$49,836.

AGREEMENT WITH BUDGET AND CONTROL BOARD, HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGEMENT DIVISION,
STAFF DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING UNIT

At the 6/21/90 meeting of the Commission, the Department was authorized to implement the UMTA/Section 18-Rural Transit Assistance Program (RTAP) -- Item #: PT-216. The Commission also authorized, on 6/21/90, under the FY '90-'91 Program of Projects, the expenditure of funds associated with workshops and conferences under the UMTA Section 8 program (Item #: PT-205). South Carolina's program emphasis is aimed at providing training opportunities to/for rural and small urban public transportation operations so as to increase their overall effectiveness.

As part of the '90-'91 training, it is requested that the Commission authorize the Department to enter into a letter of agreement with the Budget and Control Board's Human Resource Management Division (HRM) in the amount of \$49,344. HRM would provide the Department's Public Transportation Division (PTD) logistical assistance and be responsible for workshop facility arrangements, promotional material and distribution, pre-registration and registration, lodging and meals for workshop participants.

AGREEMENT WITH THE SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION & TOURISM

The South Carolina Department of Parks, Recreation and Tourism (PRT) has submitted a proposal to the Department to jointly fund a study to determine/assess the need and impact of public transportation on the State's tourism industry. The total project cost is \$70,000. Annually, PRT allocates funds for tourism-related research. During FY '90-'91, PRT proposes to fund 50% (\$35,000) of this research project from its designated research source, and requests the SCDHPT to fund the remaining 50% (\$35,000).

The proposed study will look at ways to broaden the support base for public transportation on a statewide basis. It will also show how the current five billion dollar economic impact of tourism on South Carolina can influence usage of existing public transportation systems Statewide. Furthermore, the study will provide an action plan for implementation and indicate where opportunities exist for system expansion and creation.

Under the Department's Public Transportation Division FY '90-'91 budget, funds have been allocated through the State General Fund for a worthwhile joint venture of this nature.

It is, therefore, recommended that the Commission authorize the Department to enter into an agreement with the South Carolina Department of Parks, Recreation and Tourism to conduct a study and assessment of the needs and impact of public transportation on the State's tourism industry for a contract maximum not to exceed \$35,000.00.

SALE OF SURPLUS RIGHT OF WAY PROPERTY - LAND

During acquisition of right of way for construction of improvements on U.S. Route 378 B.P. & Road S-1034 (Improvements at Intersection with U.S. Route 521), under File 43.612, the Department acquired right of way on Tract 8 from Gradon Wilsey, et al, by Condemnation dated February 22, 1988, including a remainder.

During negotiations with the adjoining landowner an agreement was reached for an exchange of the above referenced remainder for additional right of way and rights of access as may be needed for controlled access facilities. Therefore, a gratis quitclaim deed conveying approximately 14,550 SF of land to Myers-Park, Inc. was executed on October 13, 1989.

This matter is reported to the Commission in accordance with the requirements of Code Section 57-5-340.

SURPLUS RIGHT OF WAY PROPERTY - LAND

Under File 16.550, for construction of Road S-1081 in Darlington County, the Department acquired an easement from Julius T. Jackson, being recorded on South Carolina Department of Highways and Public Transportation plans for Road S-1081, File 16.550.

At the request of an adjoining owner, an investigation was made and it was determined that a portion of this property could be exchanged for right of way of equal size and value to clear a portion of a building situated on the right of way. Therefore, a quitclaim deed conveying approximately 1,300 SF of land to William E. Crawford was executed on April 17, 1990, for consideration of exchange of property.

This Agreement is intended to memorialize understandings related to the voluntary retirement of HERMAN P. SNYDER (SNYDER), State Highway Engineer currently on voluntary leave, as an employee of the COMMISSION OF THE SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS AND PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION (COMMISSION). Both SNYDER and COMMISSION, as the parties to this Agreement, recognize that the agreement contemplates sacrifices and concessions on both sides, with the ultimate objective being to enable SNYDER and his family to pursue their private lives freed of the pressures of public employment, while enabling the COMMISSION to fulfill its duties in providing the South Carolina Department of Highways and Public Transportation (Department) with the earliest possible replacement for the position of State Highway Engineer, consistent with the dictates of Section 57-3-470 of the 1976 South Carolina Code of Laws, as amended.

The parties therefore enter into this Agreement as follows:

1. SNYDER agrees to voluntarily retire as State Highway Engineer, effective August 18, 1990.
2. SNYDER agrees to make himself available at no compensation to the Department as consultant and/or witness for a period of six (6) months from date of retirement, in order to permit smooth transition of responsibility for matters peculiarly within the knowledge of SNYDER, and to enable Department access to SNYDER as an engineering or other witness for the Department

in matters in litigation where SNYDER is required by Court Order, subpoena, or other legal means to appear as witness for deposition or trial.

3. SNYDER further agrees to release the COMMISSION, its past and present members, the Department, its officers and employees from any and all liability, if any, resulting from SNYDER'S employment with the Department and SNYDER'S voluntary retirement from employment with the Department.

4. SNYDER agrees not to seek future salaried employment with the Department, it being understood by all parties that it is not the intention of this provision to prevent SNYDER and any future employer of SNYDER from being utilized in the future as an independent engineering consultant or contractor for the Department or any other agency of State government.

5. Department agrees to pay the South Carolina State Retirement System the sum of Seventy Thousand (\$70,000.) Dollars to be considered by the parties as mandatory tax deferred contribution to the retirement account of HERMAN P. SNYDER.

6. This Agreement is contractual and not merely recital.

7. It is understood that this Agreement is subject to review and approval by the South Carolina Budget and Control Board. If this Agreement is not approved by the South Carolina Budget and Control Board, it shall be void and of no effect.

The aforesaid Agreement is entered into freely and voluntarily by both parties, in hopes of amicably resolving a strained employment situation generated by events of the past year, with this Agreement intending to enable the parties to

proceed with private lives on the one hand, and statutory responsibilities on the other hand.
