Here is the information attached which shows the provisos across time.

Beginning in 2009-10, the extra subsidy was \$700 more per weighted pupil unit.

In 2009-10 that would be \$3,034 (Base student cost appropriated of \$2,334 plus \$700). The \$2,334 includes stimulus funds.

In 2010-11, the subsidy was \$2,330 (Base student cost of \$1,630 plus \$700) based on the EFA base student cost as appropriated.

Then the subsidy was raised in 2011-12 to the \$1,700 for virtual and \$3,250 for brick and mortar above the base student cost.

Please feel free to have my numbers checked by the SC Public Charter School District.
