Description/Significant Features:

The house is a one-story, frame residence, resting on a brick pier foundation, with a front-gabled roof. The front elevation is three bays wide, with an off-center door that is flanked by a single six-over-six, double-hung, wooden sash window on either side. A shed-roofed porch, supported by square posts, spans the width of the front elevation. The east and west elevations each have two single six-over-six, double-hung, wooden sash windows evenly spaced along the façade. The house is covered with wooden weatherboard siding and the roof is standing-seam metal.
