Boeing officials have postponed the 787 Dreamliner flyover until 2:00 pm today due to weather.

The flyover is set tentatively today at 2 p.m., Friday, April 17, and will be approaching from the south from tee to green over the 18th fairway.

Safety is the primary focus of Boeing. Due to cloud cover, FAA officials have determined that 2 p.m. is the optimal time.
