Description/Significant Features:

The structure is a one-story, frame house with a front-gabled roofline. The front elevation has a three bays, with a central doorway flanked by paired six-over-six, double-hung, vinyl sash windows on either side; a full-width, gabled porch, supported by decorative metal posts, spans the front elevation. The north and south elevations each have two single six-over-six, double-hung, vinyl sash windows. A gabled rear addition has been appended to the eastern elevation.
