- End up in a four way tie @ -6 (278) with Stuart Abbleby, Steve Elkington, and Thomas

Levet

- Play the 4 hole playoff even with Levet, Abbleby and Elkington are eliminated
- Win it on the 1st sudden death playoff hole (5th hole of the playoff) with a par when Levet bogied

2012 Open Championship @ Royal Lytham & St. Annes

- 6 shots down after 54 holes
- Shoot 68 in the Final Round for a -7 (273) total
- Beat Adam Scott by 1 stroke after he shoots 75
