

The next closest private ambulance service that provides non-emergency transportation is approximately 17 miles away from Turbeville, South Carolina.

East Clarendon Metro-Care Ambulance Service has applied to become an Access2Care provider and they are having difficulty getting any response back from this company. They believe that they have made a complete application, however they have not received any correspondence back from Access2Care.
